**FROM YOUR VICE COMMODORE**

All the races this year have been raced, all the trophies have been engraved, Opening Day is long past as well as the Commodore's Ball and General Meetings. It has been a delight to serve with Dana, the Board, and the fleets. I have started transitioning from Rear Commodore to Vice Commodore albeit a little prematurely. John Michener is already making a better start than I did last year to begin duties on Jan 1.

I had the pleasure of working closely with John and Paul Schmidt on the deck railings. Not only did I get to know them both a lot better, it was a delight to behold the wonderful father-son relationship that they have. Other hard workers were John Bodine, Terry Paris, John Michener, and Ron May.

The next big job is the upcoming hoist refurbishing. The Board approved funds for the job and I am anxious to get rolling. Be assured that we will not even start disassembly until the replacement parts are in hand or are assured available. Bryan Watson has volunteered to help get steel parts, Mike Brooks assures me that he can get ASME bolts overnight, and Kevin Williams has volunteered to help with metal fabrication and welding. Bob Kile (spelled right this time) continues to help with understanding the hoist as built and how to do the refurb. It will still take the help of more members to help with the actual disassembly and reassem-



bly. If you have skills that are applicable to this job, please contact me ASAP. I could especially use some engineering oversight and cross-checking, we'll need help muscling the disassembly and reassembly, electrical, and hauling. If you happen to have a crane in your backyard that you don't need for a couple of weeks, call me at your earliest convenience.

Unless we accidentally open a can of worms, I hope to have the hoist up and running by mid January with a two week margin to cover the unexpected.

The Vice Commodore's job, it seems, is not as much the great big jobs like hoist refurb, elevator installation, or deck railings, but the "small" jobs which occur frequently and randomly. If you spot something that needs fixin', the very best way to communicate that to me is by e-mail. I thought about getting an email name of "HoneyDo" and, although the ladies might be used to how this works, I figured that no gentleman in the club would feel comfortable with it. In honor of Jim Bruzenak, I then thought about "HeyWayne" as an email address but I'll wait to see what is necessary.

**"Skiffs"**

There is a new fleet in Morro Bay. We have three charter members to the new fleet they are Kenton Hendricks, Jerry White, and Kevin Williams. The new fleet will race both catamarans and skiffs.

The fleet will race in both Ocean races and Bay races. "Skiffs" are what we are calling the new fleet. Boats that are open for entry into the new fleet are International 14's, Contenders, Tazars, and anything odd, different, and fast.

Lasers are welcome to come join us out on the water as well. We are also allowing for catamarans to join into this fleet too. Primarily we are creating a new "class" for racing.

The following has been decided thus far. The skiff fleet will have its own start in both Ocean and Bay races. When racing in Ocean races, the skiffs will start ten minutes behind the Ocean fleet. When racing in the bay, the skiff fleet will have a "class" start TBD by the daily PRO.

The skiff fleet is actively looking for a Tornado, or similar catamaran to make a motorized safety boat for Ocean racing. The necessity of a safety boat has long held up Ocean racing for the skiff fleet. Additionally, races in the Ocean will make increase fuel costs, these costs will be transferred to the skiff racers by a separate entry fee TBD.

So far, entry into the Skiff fleet is free, however in the near future annual dues will be charged to cover the costs of the safety boat. Speaking of safety, all skiffs sailing in the ocean races are required to carry at least two forms of communication, and one source of navigation. The navigation must be good enough to get the racer back to the club safely when the dense fog sets in. For example, on my boat I carry a dry box with my cell phone, handheld waterproof VHF, a mapping handheld waterproof GPS, and insurance.

There are a few items that are left to be sorted out. One, who runs the safety boat, is it alternating or a "hired driver"? Two, do we need PRO's to sight the line or are we going to trust everyone on starts and finishes? Three, how will we calculate winners in cross pollinated classes? These things will be discussed at our first meeting, to be held in January, notification will be sent out via webmail.

So if you have a skiff, or a catamaran, and believe that you are ready for it, let one of the three of us know.

I enjoyed the Lighted Boat Parade which is sponsored

by the Morro Bay Chamber of Commerce. We had a large group of people at the club to watch the parade. I was very impressed with the creativity that went into the twenty-four decorated boats. Two of my favorites also won prizes. Club members Todd and Joyce Hansen turned the mast of their sail boat into a lighted palm tree and had a Hawaiian theme. They received the prize in the sail boat category. The best in show went to a big lighted sea-horse pulling a mermaid in a sleigh, built by the Hermann family. The juniors also did a beautiful job of decorating Kiskadee, Peter Behman's F&C 44.

I would like to thank the people who have already signed up to PRO bay races. We still need more volunteers. The Bay race signup schedule is posted in the case beneath the club stairway for Bay Fleet PRO's. People who are not Bay racers can also get involved. It is a very good opportunity to get to know people, have fun, and learn about racing. People are always there willing to help with what you don't know. 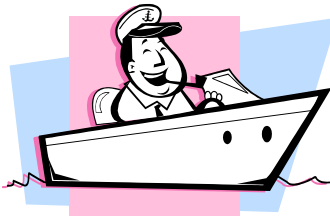

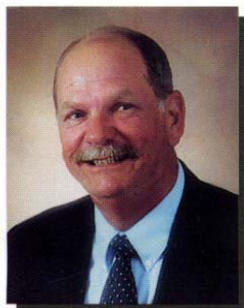
