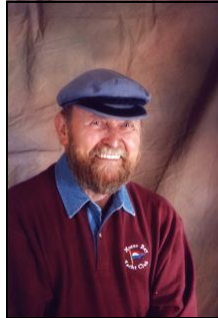

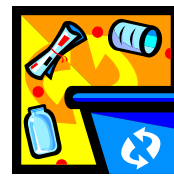
The new curtains are mostly installed but you probably won't notice them unless you look closely. They are nearly identical to the old ones, except that the rotation

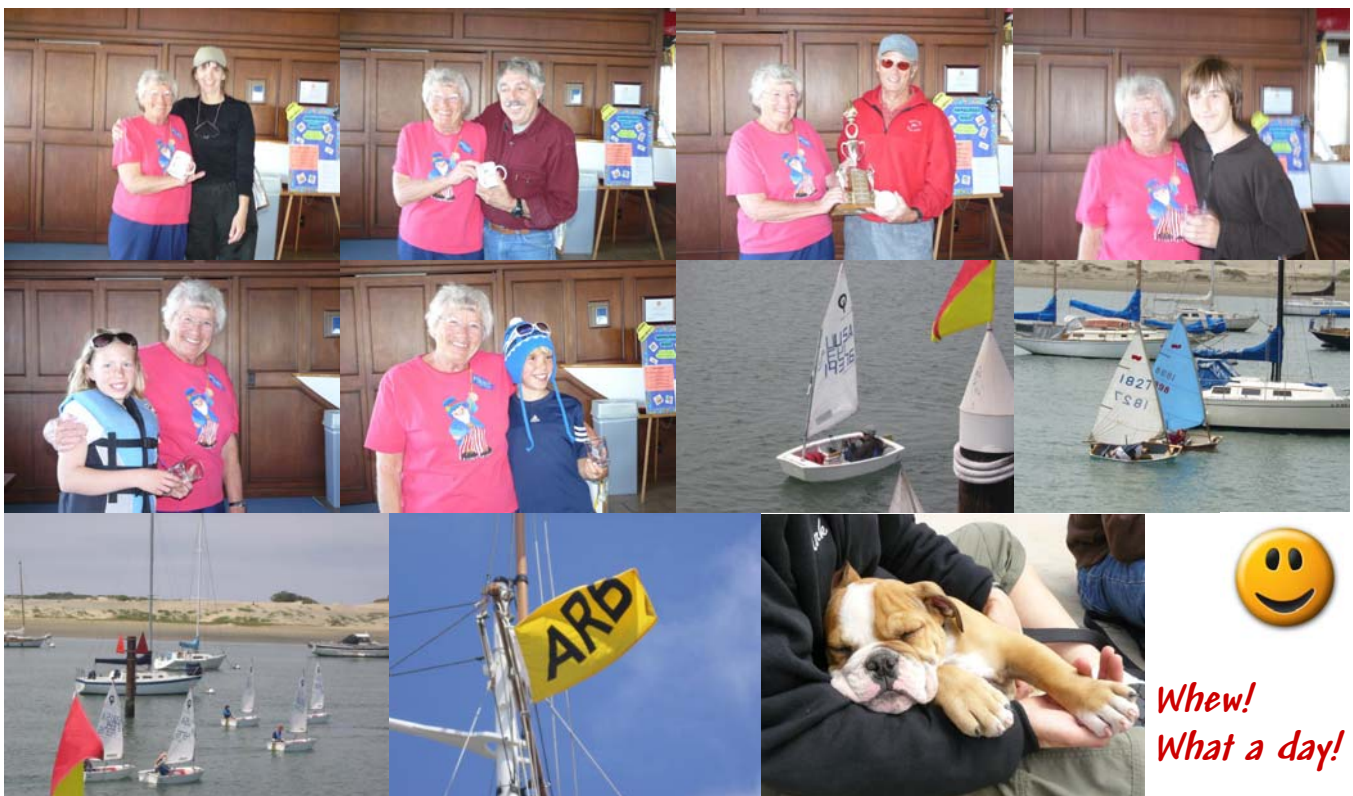
