


### FROM YOUR REAR COMMODORE—John Kincade

As the newly appointed MBYC Sommelier or Wine Stewart, I am devoting this first tasting note to introducing myself. My wife, and new MBYC Ships Stores Manager, **Yvonne Lazear**, have been members of the MBYC for just less than a year. Yvonne's

retirement as Pricing/Cost Manager from Northrop Grumman late last year, and mine as Fellow of the Technical Staff from Motorola in 2009, allowed us to move in to our Morro Bay house full time just after New Year. In addition to being long time sailors, we are also long time oenophiles, not victims of a social disease but rather wine connoisseurs.
