

2014 CHRIS LOCKWOOD MBYC JUNIOR REGATTA Notice of Race Sunday September 21, 2014

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the 20013-16 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS); and as modified by: the Class Rules of the boats competing, the sailing instructions and this Notice of Race.
- 1.2 RRS 40 is changed to apply at all times while on the water. regardless of whether or not code flag "Y" is flown.
- 1.3 Opti Sailors must have a whistle attached to their life vest..

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to all sailors 17 years of age and under.
- 2.2 Each entrant must submit a completed MBYC Entry Form prior to 10:00 am on Sunday, September 21. All competitors must have their Entry Form signed by a parent or guardian. Entry forms are available at the MBYC website.
- 2.3 Opti fleet assignments (Other than the green fleet) will be based on the skippers age on the first day of the regatta. Skippers can race Optimists until they turn 16 years old . Green fleet is for beginners in order to encourage novice sailors up to the age of 16.
- 2.4 This will be class racing with a minimum of three boats constituting a class. All Lasers classes will race together with no handicaps.
- 2.5 Juniors may have an adult crew/advisor aboard a two person boat. At the beginning of the start sequence the adult may not touch the tiller to do so would result in disqualification.
- **3. FEES**: The cost to enter the regatta is \$5.00. The fee includes, breakfast, snacks, "root beer floats" and race awards.

4. SCHEDULE

0800-1000 hrs Registration and Check-In

1000 hrs Entry Deadline.

1015 hrs Skippers meeting

1100 hrs Warning Signal for First Race

(subsequent races to start ASAP)

Five (5) races are scheduled: The race committee will try to get as many races .as is practical. Note; the Race Committee may run fewer races than the scheduled five at its discretion.

7. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply. One race must be completed to constitute a regatta. Appendix A2 is modified as follows: there no throw outs.
