



The Yacht Club's sailboat racing program depends on volunteers to act as PRO, Race Committee and safety boat crew. Some of you might be reluctant to volunteer because you might have little or no experience. Dot and Pat Rygh have volunteered to PRO the Bay Fleet's Spring I race on Saturday, March 12. They will use this opportunity to provide training for anyone interested in serving as a Race Committee or as PRO. This is an excellent opportunity to get some experience. We need at least two people to run the Safety boat. We will not race without a properly manned safety boat. If you would like to see what it is all about, come to the club on race day and cheer for your favorite sailors. Signup sheets for Ocean Fleet PRO and Bay Fleet, PRO, Race Committee, and safety boat crew are posted on the glass case doors on the left side the of stairs at the club. The complete results for Winter 1&2, Drum Stick, and Hangover races are also posted in the same case.

This year's New Years Day arbitrary Hangover Race was very exciting to watch. It is possible the cheering section and race committee had more fun than the racers. There were a total of five Day Sailers and four Lasers on the starting line for the 11:00 start. The temperature was cool (mid-50s) with an occasional rain shower. In fact, they practiced sailing backwards for an extend period of time.

Skippers were informed by the PRO they needed show their US Sailing membership card or pay \$10.00 for registration rather than the \$5.00 paid by members. In an effort to get his boat off the sand, Carlton got out of his boat to "PUSH" it off the sand. Bay Fleet Winter II was Saturday, January 15. The winds were from the north east most of the day. Tidal current was moderate. Shallow water near the marks created some challenges for the racers. The biggest challenge for the racers was limited experience of the PRO (that would be me).
