

2024 CHRIS LOCKWOOD MBYC JUNIOR REGATTA Notice of Race Sunday October 13, 2024

1. RULES

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS); and as modified by: the Optimist Class Rules, the sailing instructions and this Notice of Race.

RRS 40.2 is changed to apply at all times while on the water. regardless of whether or not code flag "Y" is flown. Opti Sailors must have a whistle attached to their life vest..

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to all sailors 17 years of age and under or still in High School.
- 2.2 Each entrant must submit a completed MBYC Entry Form prior to 10:00 am on Sunday, October 13. All competitors must have their Entry Form signed by a parent or guardian. Entry forms are available at the MBYC website.
- 2.3 Skippers can race Optimists until they turn 16 years old.
- 2.4 This will be class racing with a minimum of three boats constituting a class. The Laser class may race arbitrary at the discretion of the Race Committee
- 2.5 Juniors may have an adult crew/advisor aboard a two person boat. At the beginning of the start sequence the adult may not touch the tiller to do so would result in disqualification.
- **3. FEES**: The cost to enter the regatta is \$ 5.00. The fee includes, the race, morning snacks, after racing "root beer float table" and race awards.

5. NUMBER OF RACES Five races are scheduled: The race committee will try to get as many races as is practical. Note; the Race Committee may run fewer races than the scheduled five at its discretion. One race must be completed to constitute a regatta.
